BACKGROUND

RA 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Act, and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regula tions (IRR) provide for the proper implementation of public procurement by government entities. With this, the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) through its Technical Support Office (TSO) is implementing its mandate to professionalize and establish a sustainable training program to capacitate the Bids and Awards Committees (BACs), the BAC Secretariats, the Technical Working Groups (TWGs) of procuring entities, other government procurement officers, and employees directly or indirectly involved in public procurement including private suppliers, contractors and service providers.

To concretize its mission of continuous empowerment of public procurement employees and officials, the GPPB-TSO has collaborated with the Cagayan State University- Graduate School (CSU-GS) through the signing of a Memorandum of Agreement between GPPB and CSU on April 6, 2017 to offer the Certified Public Procurement Specialist Course Program. The program comprises three levels of certification:

The objective of the program is to produce certified public procurement specialists and practitioners imbued with the required body of knowledge and skills, appropriate attitudes and behaviors for public procurement. This is to achieve operational excellence and quality performance of public procurement systems towards good governance.

All personnel in public and private organizations involved in public procurement such as: BAC Members, Procurement TWGs, BAC Secretariat, Supply Officers, Accountants, Budget Officers, Administrative Officers, Project Managers/Supervisors and Private Bidders.
